**GENERAL RULES FOR PERMITTED "OPEN BURNING"**

1. A permit must be secured for each burning operation where conditions can not be met for allowed open burning.
2. A hazardous condition, air pollution or nuisance may not be created and all reasonable means must be employed to minimize smoke.
3. Materials which produce dense smoke such as tires and roofing materials will not be burned.
4. The material to be burned shall have originated on the premises on which it is to be burned.
5. Fire Control Laws or regulations of other governmental agencies will not be violated.
6. Adequate personnel and equipment shall be present to prevent the fire from escaping.
7. At least one responsible person shall remain at the location of the fire until the last spark is out.
8. If material is within 200 ft. of woodland, or flammable materials that would ignite and carry fire to woodland, approval must be obtained from the Forest Ranger Department of Natural Resources, Forest Service and all burning must comply with their regulations.
