For immediate release:

Today, health officials in conjunction with the Kent County Commissioners are announcing the second confirmed case of COVID-19 in Kent County. The County resident, a male individual in his 70's, has no known travel history. The resident received testing on March 23, 2020, and results were reported to the Health Department late last night. "As COVID-19 is now widespread in Maryland, it is likely that we will continue to identify more positive cases in the County," said William Webb, Kent County Health Officer. "A contact tracing investigation is underway to determine exposure within the County, and we are working with the Maryland Department of Health to take the appropriate precautions."
