Who should get a booster?

- Everyone 12 and older who received their second dose of Pfizer more than 5 months ago.
- Everyone 18 and older who received their second dose of Moderna more than 5 months ago.
- Everyone 18 and older who received their single dose of Johnson & Johnson more than 2 months ago.

***3rd doses are different from booster doses.** 3rd or “additional primary” doses are only for people ages 5 and up who are moderately or severely immunocompromised and may not have mounted a robust immune response after their first two doses. An additional dose of vaccine 28 days after their second shot of Moderna or Pfizer is recommended. No additional primary shot is recommended at this time for those who received the single dose of Johnson & Johnson. Immunocompromised people should talk to their healthcare provider about their medical condition, and whether getting an additional primary shot is appropriate for them.

Vaccines for ages 5+ are also available through local pharmacies.

What to know on the day of your vaccine:

- Bring a photo ID (and your CDC vaccination card if you are coming for your 2nd dose, or booster)
- Wear short sleeves and a face mask.
- If you have been COVID-19 positive defer vaccination until you have recovered from the acute illness (symptoms) and criteria have been met to discontinue isolation.
- If you have been advised to quarantine due to an exposure to a positive COVID-19 case, wait until the quarantine period is finished to make an appointment.
- You will be asked to use hand sanitizer upon entering the building, complete a verbal health screening and have your temperature taken.
- There will be an observation period following COVID-19 vaccination. Individuals will wait for 15 minutes and will be released when the observation period is over.
- A parent/guardian must accompany all children aged 5-17.
