



Kent County Health Department Announces Vaccine Clinics for Week Feb. 8-12

Please read this entire message before attempting to register for a COVID-19 Vaccine appointment.

A PUBLIC COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic is scheduled for Wednesday, February 10th at the Kent County Community Center in Worton. Individuals in Phase 1A and seniors age 65 and older may register if they live or work in the County.

Although Maryland has moved to Phase 1C, local jurisdictions have been instructed to prioritize the elderly. There are simply not enough doses available yet for everyone who is eligible to receive them. That means it may be weeks or longer before vaccination appointments become available for those who are eligible. Anyone who receives the first dose of the vaccine will receive the second dose approximately four weeks later.

There are two types of clinics next week:

- The CLOSED clinics are by invitation only from our partner agencies.
- **The PUBLIC clinic is by APPOINTMENT ONLY and is ONLY open to those in Group 1A or those 65 years of age and older who live or work in a Kent County, MD zip code. You must bring documentation to your appointment. If you do not meet the criteria below your appointment will be canceled.**
 - Proof of 1A Eligibility OR Photo ID with proof of age 65 or older
AND
 - Proof of Kent County residency, and/or ID showing Kent County employment

Before you make an appointment:

- Only attempt to register if the clinic shows available appointments.

- The Moderna vaccine should not be administered within 14 days of another vaccination. If you have had another vaccination in the last 14 days, please wait to make an appointment.
- If you have been COVID-19 positive defer vaccination until you have recovered from the acute illness (symptoms) and criteria have been met to discontinue isolation.
- If you have been advised to quarantine due to an exposure to a positive COVID-19 case, wait until the quarantine period is finished to make an appointment.

If you meet the criteria above for the PUBLIC clinics you are invited to make an appointment at marylandvax.org Registration will open at approximately 10:00 am Wednesday, February 3rd.

At this time, vaccine supply is extremely limited and these appointments will go quickly. If you are unsuccessful in your registration attempt, please be reassured that more clinics will be added as more vaccine supply is received. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
