## **Kent County Health Department Vaccine Clinics March 1-5**

---

The Kent County Health Department typically offers two types of clinics: CLOSED, and PUBLIC.

- The CLOSED clinics are usually for employees in priority designations (i.e, education, or continuity of government) or other identified groups such as assisted living facilities. Our 2nd dose clinics are also considered CLOSED because they are by email invitation only to people who have received their 1st dose through KCHD.
- 
- The PUBLIC 1st dose clinics are open to those who meet the eligibility criteria.

Like last week, we did not receive the quantity of vaccine that was requested for the week. All doses that have been allocated will be used to complete the vaccination series for those needing a second dose (at a CLOSED clinic). Therefore, there will not be a PUBLIC clinic for those seeking their first dose next week.

We look forward to adding new public clinics in the weeks ahead and thank you for your continued patience and understanding.
