



Kent County Health Department Vaccine Clinics Week of April 26-30

TYPES OF CLINICS:

The Kent County Health Department typically offers two types of clinics: PUBLIC and CLOSED.

- The PUBLIC First Dose Clinics are open to those who are age 18+. **Next week, there is a public First Dose clinic on Wednesday, April 28th from 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM.**
- The CLOSED clinics are usually for individuals in higher risk groups that have been prioritized for outreach such as our seniors. **2nd dose clinics are Closed Clinics as they are only for individuals who received their 1st dose through KCHD. Individuals will receive an email to make an appointment 10 days before their 2nd dose is due.**

Type: CLOSED Second Dose Clinic
For: Those being assisted by partnering faith-based organizations, vaccinated on 3/31.
