TYPES OF CLINICS:

- The PUBLIC Clinics are open to those who meet the age guidelines as stated in the clinic description.
- The PRIVATE Clinics are for businesses/organizations not open to the public.
- Second Dose clinics are CLOSED Clinics as they are only for individuals who received their 1st dose Moderna or Pfizer vaccine through KCHD. For individuals receiving the Moderna product, you will be emailed approximately 18 days after your first shot to make an appointment for your 2nd shot. For individuals receiving the Pfizer product, you will be emailed approximately 11 days after your first shot to make an appointment for your 2nd shot.
