THE A.F. WHITSITT CENTER IS NOW ACCEPTING WALK-INS FOR IMMEDIATE ACCESS TO ADDICTION TREATMENT ON WEDNESDAYS FROM 9:00AM TO 11:00AM
PROVIDING BED AVAILABILITY

Walk-ins will be assessed and / or admitted on a first come, first serve basis, pending medical necessity determination.

It is recommended that you call the day before to check bed availability. There is no guarantee of bed availability even for individuals coming from several hours away. Referral sources should continue to use their normal referral process.

Insurance and Other Important Information:

1. If you are traveling from a long distance away, please call ahead of time.
2. **We cannot accept couples, siblings, or close family members**, (husband and wife, brother and sister, significant other, mother and father, boyfriend and girlfriend). **We can accept one OR the other, but not both at the same time.**
3. **If you are pregnant, you must have approval from your Doctor / OBGYN for treatment.**
4. You **MUST** have insurance. If you are a Maryland resident *and you are uninsured*, you must apply for Medicaid. Please do this at your first convenience prior to coming in for a Walk-In.
5. Please visit Maryland Health Connection to apply on line, which is also available on Google.
6. Kent County residents may call the Kent County Health Department at 410-778-1350, ext.: 7039 for assistance in signing up for Medicaid.
7. **You must be a Maryland Resident-** (you must show proof of residency, i.e.: Photo ID)
8. Any legal issues you may have **MUST** be resolved *before* entry into our inpatient treatment – (this includes warrants, or upcoming court dates, etc.)
9. *If you are already in a treatment program, a referral is still required.*
10. **We ARE NOT a Methadone Facility or Methadone Program**
