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## Kent County Health Department Vaccine Clinics

### Week of March 29 - April 02

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#### **TYPES OF CLINICS:**

The Kent County Health Department typically offers two types of clinics: CLOSED, and PUBLIC.

- The CLOSED clinics are usually for employees in priority designations (i.e, education, or continuity of government) or other identified groups such as assisted living facilities. Our 2nd dose clinics are also considered CLOSED because they are by email invitation only to people who have received their 1st dose through KCHD.
- The PUBLIC First Dose Clinics are open to those who meet the eligibility criteria. **Next week, there are two public clinics on Monday, March 29th and Wednesday, March 31st. Registration will open at approximately 10 am on Wednesday, March 24th. [Visit this link to register](#) if you meet the eligibility criteria.**

#### **PRODUCT(S) OFFERED:**

**The Moderna Vaccine will be given this week.** Consumers who prefer a specific vaccine product must sign up for a clinic where that product will be offered. Recipients will not have the option to choose a manufacturer at the time of vaccination.

**Wednesday, March 31: Kent County Community Center**

**Time:** 9:00 AM-12:00 PM  
**Type:** PUBLIC First Dose Clinic  
**For:** **Those age 60 or older, OR in Phase 1A, 1B, 1C occupational groups\*, OR those age 18+ with qualifying underlying medical conditions\*\*.** (All recipients at this clinic must either live or work in a Kent County Zip Code. Proof of residency and/or employment required.)  
**Product:** Moderna

**Time:** 9:00 AM-12:00 PM  
**Type:** PRIVATE First Dose Clinic  
**For:** **Those age 65+ being assisted by the Commission on Aging** (All recipients at this clinic must either live or work in a Kent County Zip Code. Proof of residency and/or employment required.)  
**Product:** Moderna

**For:** **Those being assisted by partnering faith-based organizations.**

**\*Occupational Groups:**

- **1A:** Health care workers • Staff of nursing homes • First responders • Public safety • Corrections
- **1B:** Education • Continuity of government
- **1C:** All other public safety (not in Phase 1A) • All other healthcare (not in Phase 1A), including, but not limited to, Lab Services, Public Health, Vaccine Manufacturing, other healthcare professions • Food and Agriculture Production • Critical Manufacturing • U.S. Postal Service • Public Mass Transit • Grocery Stores • Veterinarians and Support Staff • Clergy and other essential support for houses of worship

**\*\*Underlying Medical Conditions:**

**Adults age 18+ with underlying medical conditions that increase the risk of severe COVID-19 illness.** Cancer patients who are currently in active treatment • End stage renal disease patients requiring hemodialysis • Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) • Solid organ transplant recipients • Sickle cell disease patients • Diabetic patients (Type 1 and Type 2)
