



Kent County Health Department Vaccine Clinics

TYPES OF CLINICS:

The Kent County Health Department typically offers two types of clinics: CLOSED, and PUBLIC.

- The PUBLIC First Dose Clinics are open to those who are age 18+. **Next week, there is a public First Dose clinic on Wednesday, April 21st from 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM.**
- The CLOSED clinics are usually for individuals in higher risk groups that have been prioritized for outreach such as assisted living facilities. Our 2nd dose clinics are also considered CLOSED because they are by email invitation only to people who have received their 1st dose through KCHD.

Type: CLOSED First Dose Clinic
For: Those being assisted by partnering faith-based organizations
Product: Moderna

Thursday, April 22: Kent County Community Center

Time: 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM
Type: Second Dose Clinic
For: Those vaccinated at the Kent County Community Center on 3/24.
Product: Moderna

Time: 1:00 PM - 3:00 PM
Type: Second Dose Clinic
For: Those vaccinated at the Kent County Community Center on 3/24 and 3/25.
Product: Moderna
